MANAGING THE MARGINS

Providing a joined-up approach for delivering bespoke land management advice for riparian land managers and owners in the Brecks.

Aims

- Review the mechanisms for providing advice using a mutually inclusive approach
- Share Water Sensitive Farming advice (WSF) to improve water quality and quantity, soil health and biodiversity
- Develop a steering group with partner organisations to pilot a bespoke land management advice scheme that adds value to existing stewardship

How?

- Engage with land managers across the Brecks
- Undertake one-to-one farm visits
- Facilitate and hold knowledge-exchange events and produce communications materials
- Form adviser and farmer catchment groups
- Develop case studies through the advice service
- Deliver water and soil interventions such as wetlands and ponds
- Identify additional match funding opportunities
- Create habitat connectivity mapping
